- Residents are submit to random drug and alcohol screenings
- No display of gang activities
- All tattoos must be covered
- No smoking is permitted inside building or on the grounds
- Curfews are enforced
- No outside food or drinks permitted
- Appointments must be logged in with the House Manager
- Visiting hours are limited
- Telephone use is with permission
- Jobs outside of the residence must be full-time
- A dress code is enforced
- Attendance to church services is mandatory
